BATHURST AERO CLUB APPROVED PILOT REGISTER.

The Bathurst Aero Club will keep a register of those members who are authorised to operate the club aircraft, VH-BAC.*(refer schedule below)

Inclusion on the Register

Inclusion of a Financial Member of the Bathurst Aero Club to the Pilot Register is at the absolute and unfettered discretion of the Bathurst Aero Club Pilot Approval Committee*(refer schedule below) and is obtained only by application.

The Bathurst Aero Club unequivocally reserves the right to remove, or decline to accept application for inclusion, any member from the Bathurst Aero Club Approved Pilot Register at any time without assigning any explanation.

Members will remain on the Register for 1 year following their last hire of BAC or the expiry of their Club membership, whichever occurs first. After that time their position on the Register will lapse and they will be required to re apply for inclusion.

The Register includes those Members who are not currently licensed, but who intend to hire BAC for the purposes of Flight Training with one of the Bathurst Aero Club Nominated Flight Training Organisations.

Application for Inclusion on the Register

Members applying for inclusion on the Bathurst Aero Club Approved Pilots Register may be required to undertake a proficiency test with one of the nominated Flight Training Organisations before their application for inclusion on the register will be considered.

Requirement for Proficiency Check

Bathurst Aero Club may, in its absolute discretion, at any time, and from time to time, require a member to undergo a proficiency check with any of the nominated Flight Training Organisations in order to remain nominated on the Bathurst Aero Club Approved Pilot Register.

Proficiency Check

For the purposes of application for entry to the register, or as required by the Bathurst Aero Club to remain on the register, a proficiency check will consist of:

- · A Biannual Flight Review or,
- A demonstration to the satisfaction of the approved Flight Training Organisation of any flight sequences deemed appropriate by the Flight Instructor on the day with the minimum of sequences being 3 take offs and 3 landings.
